

## 4-(Methylamino)butyric Acid Analyzed by HPLC-AppNote

## A gamma-Aminobutyric Acid (GABA) Derivative

This challenging polar compound is easily retained in this simple Method where repeatability of the data is excellent with %RSD<0.1 for the Retention Times.

**Column:** Cogent Diamond Hydride<sup>™</sup>, 4μm, 100Å

**Mobile Phase:** 

A: DI Water with 0.1% Formic Acid B: Acetonitrile with 0.1% Formic Acid

**Detection:** ELSD (Evaporative Light Scattering Detector)

Sample Preparation: 4-(Methylamino) Butyric Acid 0.1mg / mL in 50:50 Acetonitrile / DI Water

Note: 4-(Methyamino)butyric acid is a GABA (gamma Aminobutyric Acid) derivative and product of N-methyl-2-pyrrolidione. It inhibits L-Carnitine from undergoing beta-oxidation in mammals. In bacteria it is a product of nicotine catabolism. It is found in skin products to prevent wrinkles.



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
