

What makes one HPLC fitting different from another - FAQ

Of course, the quality of the manufacturing is important but besides that the most important features of all fittings are:

- 1. Geometry of the receiving port you are putting the fitting into.
- 2. Threads on the fitting and receiving port count per inch and total length of threads.
- 3. Material the fitting is made out of for purposes of chemical inertness, temperature the fitting will be used for.
- 4. Pressure the fitting will be required to hold.
- 5. Size of the tubing the fitting will be holding.
