

Could your PEEK tubing have contaminants via manufacturing processes from previous extrusion runs - FAQ

The process of extrusion involves the use of air to inflate the tubing. Apart from air, no other substance comes into contact with the interior of the tubing.

However, the exterior may not have the same purity as the interior.
